

What Students Must Know about SAT Test Day

Must Bring

- Their admission ticket ([sign in](#) to print ticket)
- [Acceptable photo ID](#)
- Two No. 2 pencils
- [An approved calculator](#)

Can Bring

- A watch without an audible alarm
- A drink and/or snack for the break

Do Not Bring

- Tablets, computers, cameras, or most other [electronic devices](#)
- Highlighters, pens, colored pencils
- Books or papers

Timing

- They should arrive at the test center by 7:45 a.m.
- The SAT® with Essay ends between 12:50 and 1:20 p.m.
- The SAT without Essay ends between noon and 12:30 p.m.
- SAT Subject Tests™ end around 9:45 a.m., 11:15 a.m., or 12:30 p.m., depending on whether they are taking one, two, or three tests.
