- 5. Participation in community service activities. Please include resume.
- 6. Peer recommendation-100 words or less describing the candidate's attributes and ambition
- Essay 200 words or less addressing the following statement/question:
  "Already a hero to all who knew her, she became another kind of hero on that
  Tragic day. Please share your thoughts of someone you consider a hero and why."
- 8. Interview of finalists
