Purpose: To recognize a senior girl who demonstrates the ideals that were important to Lauren, who on September 11, 2001 was a passenger aboard United Airlines Flight 93.

The student must exhibit academic achievement, commitment to physical activities, involvement in the community, and possess a strong sense of independence.

Criteria:

1. Senior Female
2. 3.0 minimum GPA on a 4.0 scale
3. Demonstration of financial need a consideration but not a requirement.
4. Participation in physical/athletic activities; not necessarily team sports.
5. Participation in community service activities. Please include resume.
6. Peer recommendation-100 words or less describing the candidate's attributes and ambition
7. Essay – 200 words or less addressing the following statement/question:
"Already a hero to all who knew her, she became another kind of hero on that Tragic day. Please share your thoughts of someone you consider a hero and why."
8. Interview of finalists
